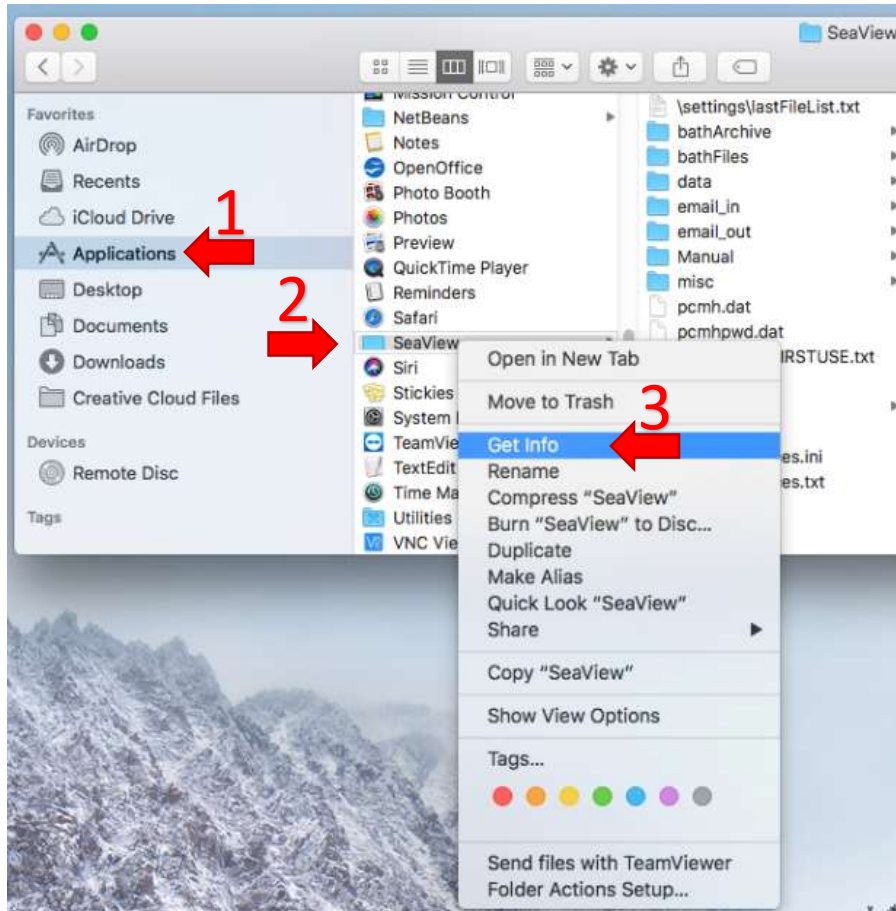
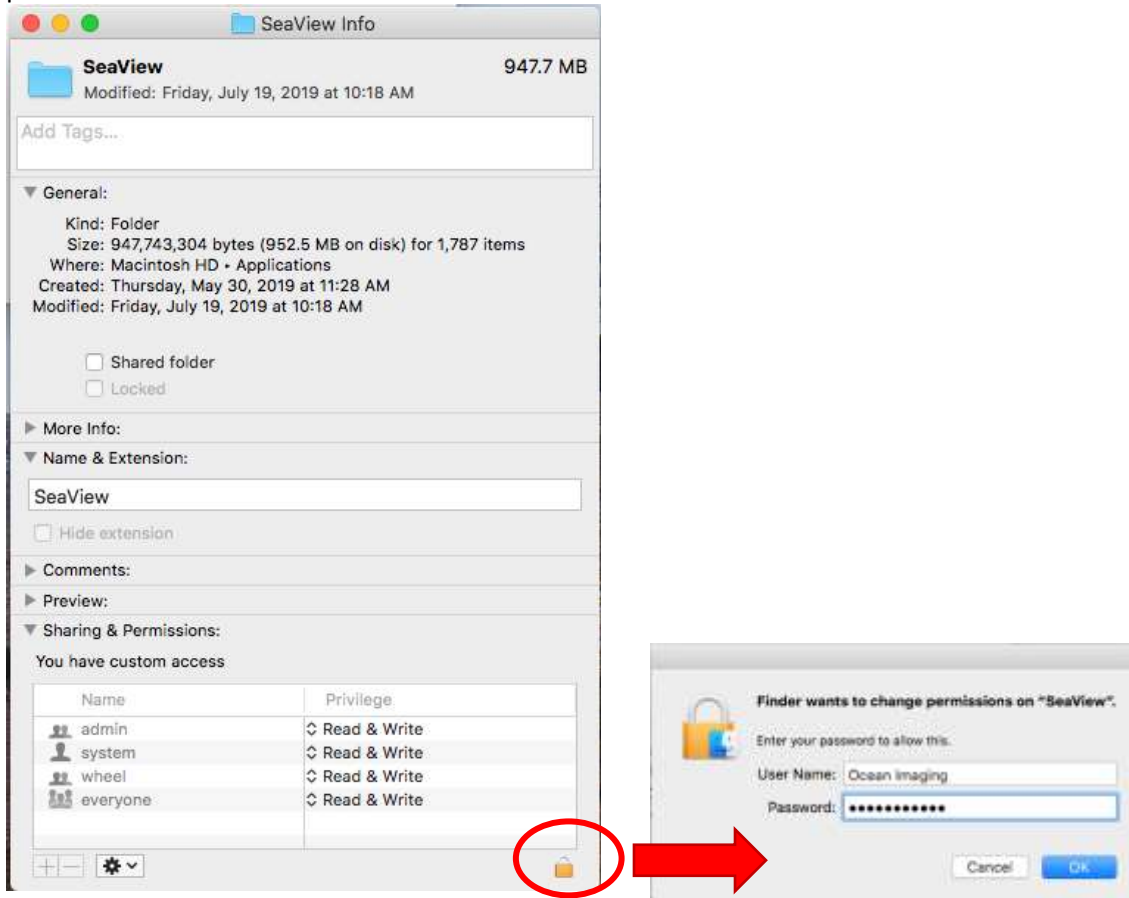


### Step 3: Set Administrator Permissions **\*\*Essential to run SeaView\*\***

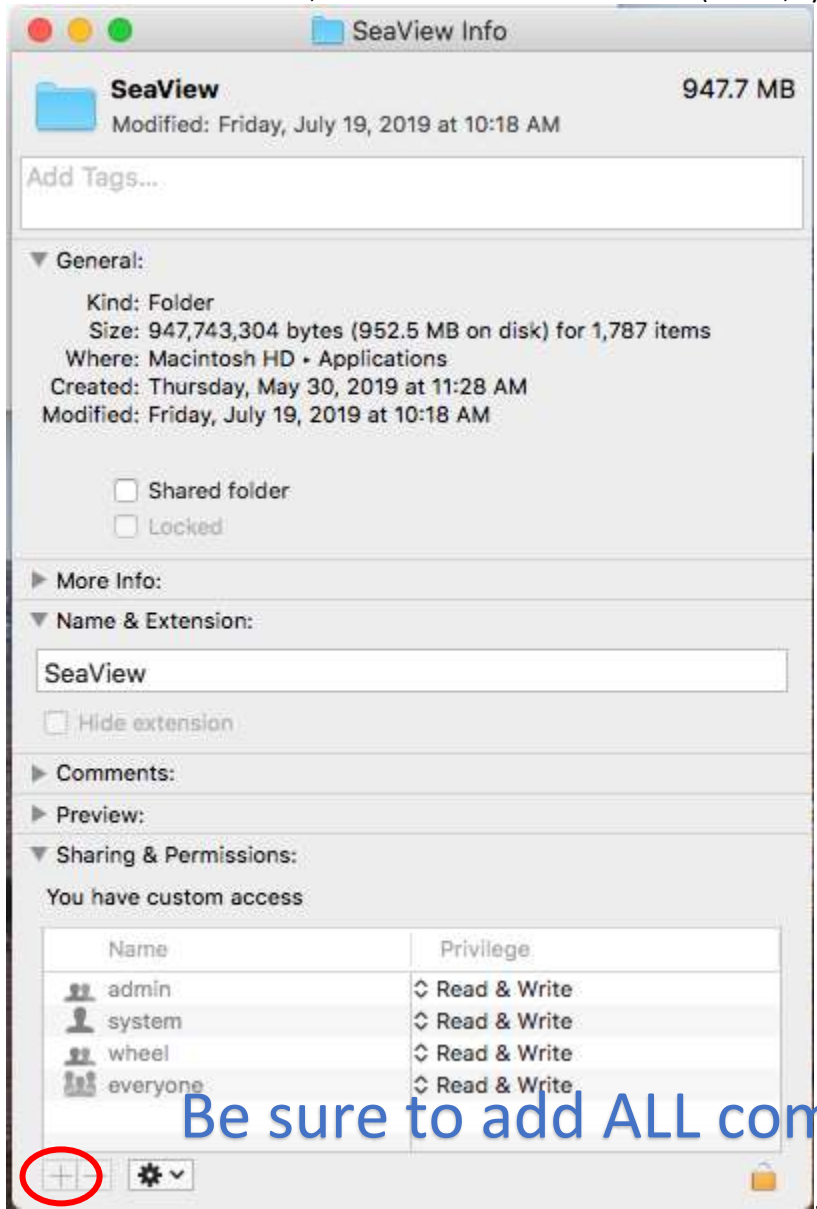
- Within **Applications (1)**, locate **the SeaView (2)** folder - Control-Click or Right-Click (if enabled) **SeaView (2)** folder then select **Get Info (3)**:



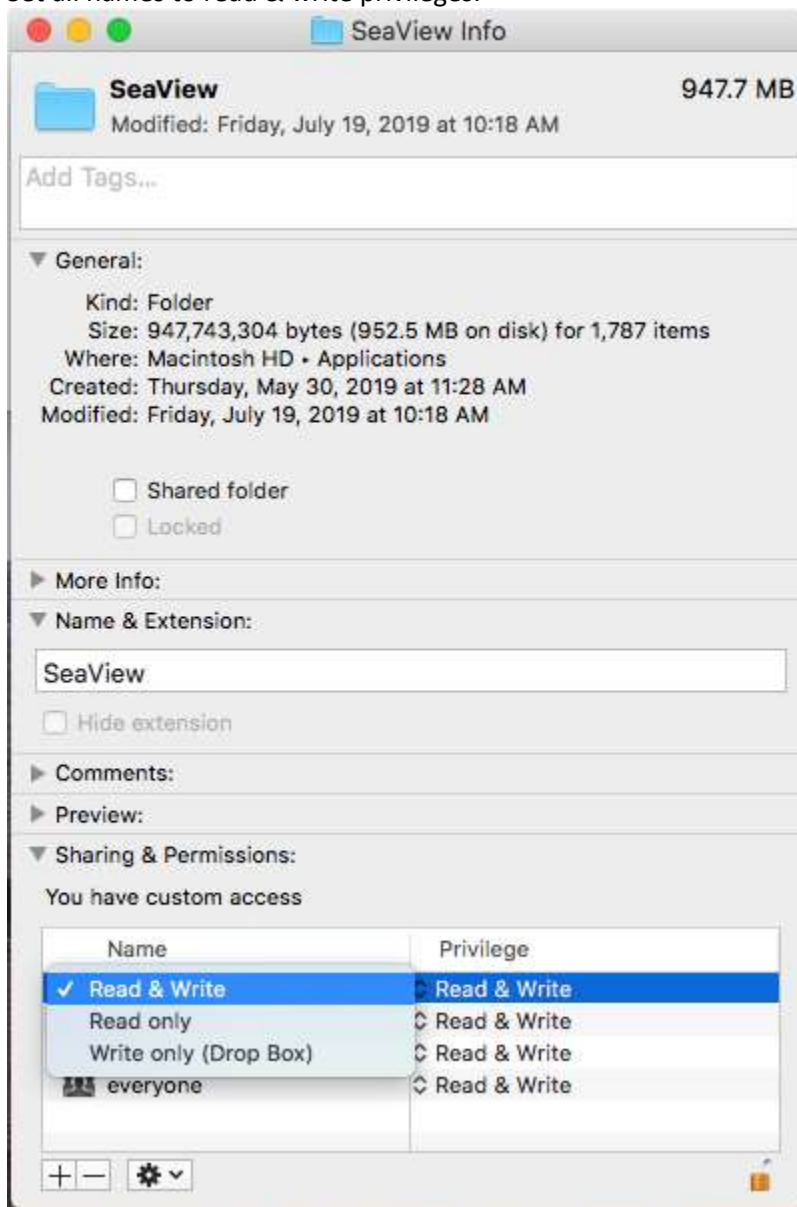
Click lock icon in bottom right to set permissions, you will be asked to enter your MasOS system password.



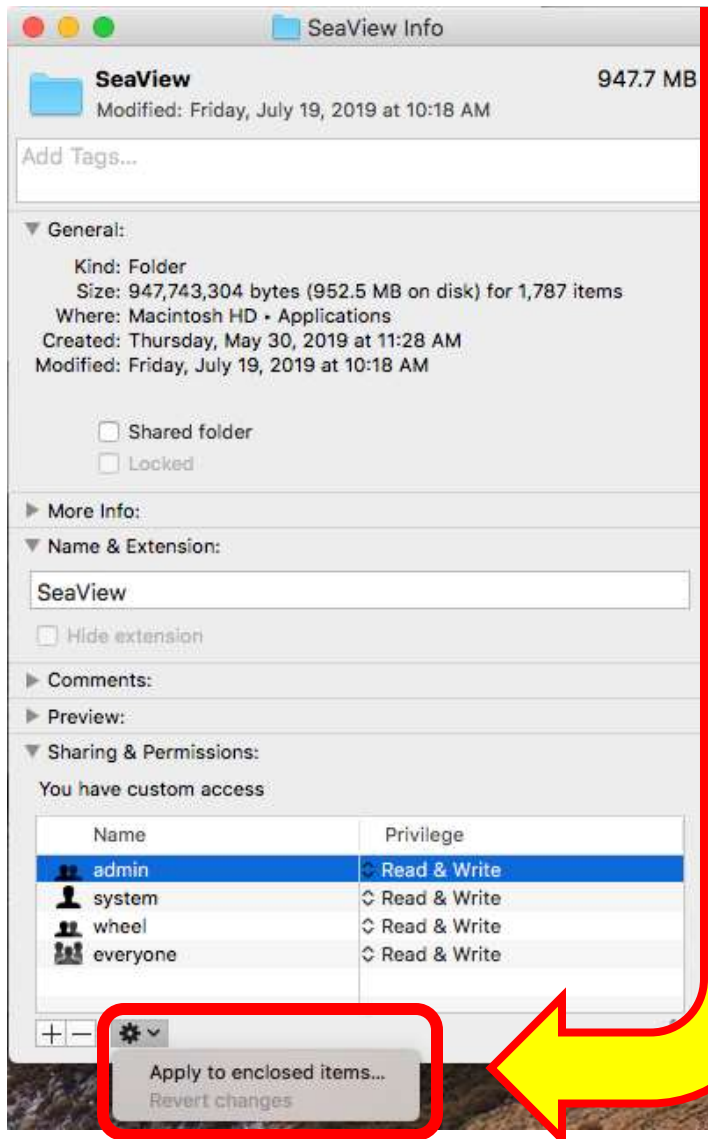
Click + icon in bottom left, then shift-click to ALL accounts (admin, system, wheel, everyone etc.... )



Set all names to read & write privileges.



Click settings icon next to + icon.

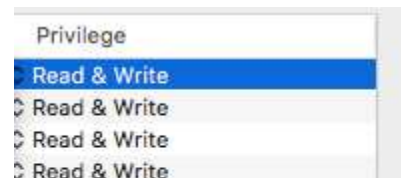
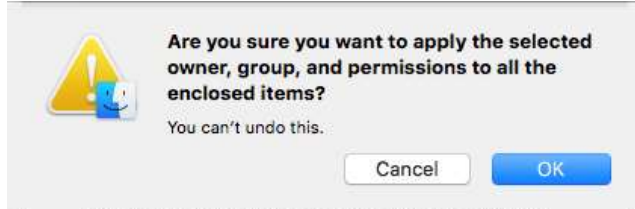
You **MUST** click on the gear icon and “Apply to Enclosed Items” before continuing. If you do not do this – SeaView will not work.
