

Step 3: Set Administrator Permissions **Essential to run SeaView**


- Within Applications (1), locate the SeaView (2) folder - Control-Click or Right-Click (if enabled) SeaView (2) folder then select Get Info (3):




Click lock icon in bottom right to set permissions, you will be asked to enter your MasOS system password.




Click + icon in bottom left, then shift-click to ALL accounts (admin, system, wheel, everyone etc....)


